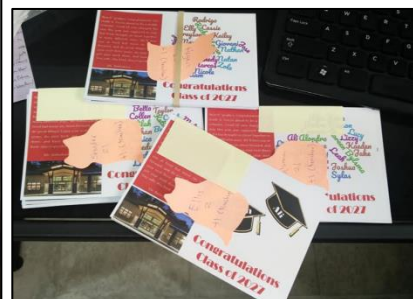

The purpose of this meeting is to review Frost's Parent and Family Engagement Plan/Policy, and to also share updates we've made in the policy in response to Covid-19. It's a super informal meeting or "focus group", which will help our school complete the OSPI Title 1 compliance piece that needs to be met by the end of the year.

The goal is to gather feedback on how Frost is ensuring two-way, meaningful communication between our families and school staff.
