

Skyward Family Access on your computer using a web browser You will find: Gradebook Attendance Student Information Schedule Test Scores Academic History Portfolio SkyLert Health Info Online Student Information Verification	The typical (not all!) username consists of the first 5 letters of the last name followed by the first 3 letters of the first name, followed by a 3 digit number. Someone with a name of JOHN LEE for example will need to fill in the extra characters with spaces. In this case, John Lee with a username of LEE JOH000, will enter "L", "E", "E", space, space, "J", "O", "H", "O", "0", "0".	10-16 characters in length including a letter, a number and a special character.	To get your username and reset your password, click on the "Forgot Your Login/Password" link on the Skyward login page http://family.lakewashington.wa-k12.net . Enter your email address on file at the school when prompted. You will receive a password reset email. <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Known Issue: Create a password that is 10-16 characters in length including a letter, a number and a special character. The system allows you to create a password longer than 16 characters, <u>but it only saves up to 16 characters!</u></p>
