 - Will be meeting with teachers January 10th to go over schedules, etc

 donations are welcome for staff appreciation
- Monthly Family Engagements to use Title 1 funds, can't be PTSA related
 - Working with Elise to figure out the best way to have the PTSA help with engagements, etc
 - How can we reach out to our community to make
- 5th Grade Camp Allie is a superstar June 12-14th
 - Allie found \$28k to fund 5th grade camp
 - Includes transportation, supplies, etc
 - Camp Dudley, 3 day/2 nights
 - OSPI/Lake Washington Foundation funds, reaching out to REI
 - How do we determine cost and utilize funds to make this sustainable?
 - Use funds to cover the cost, but still ask families who are able to pay (approx. \$200)
 - Put funds into PTSA budget, instead of school budget, so funds can be rolled over so we can use
 it when funding rolls up
 - Have plenty of adult supervision
 - Allie will be there, Elizabeth and Tyler will switch off days, other teachers will be available if something happens
 - Activities will be provided for kids who don't want to/can't go
 - Starting process in March
 - Cabins
 - 8-10 kids per cabin, 1-2 adults

- Allie will be making cabin assignments
- Allie found swim grants as well, has information for when we're looking for money for 3rd grade swim lessons

Other

- Sarah Poulin brought up flyers for classrooms
 - Provide classrooms with enough for English for the entire class, then a few extras for Portuguese and Spanish
- International Night
 - Families can choose a country and do a display/food/costume, etc
 - Need leads and volunteers
 - Tyler would like International Night to get moved to fall, so families can feel welcome culturally
- Classroom Snacks
 - PTSA has some funds for some snacks, approximately 4 fills left before money is gone
 - Trying to stretch it out
 - Put out refill dates to teachers so they are aware of when they may need to ask for snacks
- If we're not intentional about money, it can be perceived as vagueness
 - Let families know what we're raising for
 - It only takes a vote redirect any extra funds
 - Add general fund link to all fundraiser fliers
- Jodie suggested photo album on website showing fundraisers happening, and where we are using the money
